

REPORT AND ORDER

On December 3, 1987, O'Fallon Gas Service, Inc. (Applicant) filed an application with the Commission seeking a certificate of public convenience and necessity to provide metered central propane gas distribution service in Lincoln County, Missouri. By orders of the Commission, notice of the application was given and a procedural schedule was set. A timely application to intervene was filed on behalf of Union Electric Company.

At the convening of the hearing on September 8, 1988, a Stipulation and Agreement executed by all parties, proposed disposition of all issues was offered in lieu of an evidentiary presentation.

Findings of Fact

The Missouri Public Service Commission, having considered all of the competent and substantial evidence upon the whole record, makes the following findings of fact:

The Stipulation and Agreement, which has been received into evidence, delineates all matters of agreement between the signatory parties regarding the disposition of this matter and is attached hereto as Appendix A and is incorporated herein by reference.

Conclusions

The Missouri Public Service Commission has arrived at the following conclusions:

The Applicant proposes to extend operations as a public utility, subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission, pursuant to Chapters 386 and 393, RSMo 1986.

The Commission may accept a stipulated settlement on any or all contested matters submitted by the parties. Since the Commission is of the opinion that the matters of agreement between the parties in this matter are reasonable and proper the Stipulation should be accepted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That the Stipulation and Agreement entered into between the parties to this matter, identified as Exhibit 2 and attached hereto, is hereby accepted and adopted in disposition of all matters in this case.

ORDERED: 2. That for the purpose of implementing the Stipulation and Agreement entered into in this proceeding, O'Fallon Gas Service, Inc., is hereby granted an additional certificate of convenience and necessity authorizing it to construct, own, operate, control, manage and maintain a metered central propane gas

d cribution service in portions of Lincoln County, Missouri, more fully described in Tariff Sheets 1, CSA-1, CSA-2, CSA-3, CSA-4, CSA-5, and CSA-6, attached to Exhibit 2.

ORDERED: 3. That for the purposes of implementing the Stipulation and Agreement O'Fallon Gas Service, Inc., is hereby directed to file, for Commission approval, tariffs including rates, rules for service, and a service area description covering the service to be provided as a result of this Report and Order.

ORDERED: 4. That this Report and Order shall become effective on September 26, 1988.

STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT

Comes now O'Fallon Gas Service, Inc. ("Applicant"),
Intervener Union Electric Company, and the Staff of the Missouri
Public Service Commission, and stipulate and agree as follows:

- 1. On December 3, 1987, Applicant filed an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to provide metered central propane gas distribution service throughout Lincoln County, Missouri.
- 2. On April 8, 1988, the Commission granted Union Electric Company's application to intervene. The Public Counsel, although notified of the proceedings, has not participated.
- 3. The undersigned parties have met on several occasions to discuss appropriate territorial boundaries for purposes of this certificate application. After discussion and negotiation, the undersigned parties have agreed to recommend five separate service areas to the Commission for its approval pursuant to section 393.170 RSMo 1986. These areas are depicted in tariff sheets attached hereto as Exhibit A. In consideration of this position by the other parties, Applicant is willing to amend its

application hereby to restrict the territory it seeks to have certificated to the five areas identified in Exhibit A.

- 4. The parties have reviewed the seven tariff sheets in Exhibit A, designated Mo. PSC No. 4, Sheets No. 1, CSA-1, CSA-2, CSA-3, CSA-4, CSA-5, and CSA-6, and recommend that, after notice and hearing as required by §393.170 RSMo, the Commission issue an order granting a certificate of public convenience and necessity to applicant for the areas referenced in those sheets, and approving said sheets for filing with the Commission.
- 5. This Stipulation and Agreement is a negotiated settlement and the parties shall not be deemed to have approved or acquiesced to any particular regulatory or ratemaking principle by entering into same; this Stipulation and Agreement shall not prejudice, bind or affect any party hereto, except to the extent necessary to give effect to the terms of this Stipulation and Agreement.
- 6. That a hearing shall be held at the Commission, at which time the verified application of Applicant and this Stipulation and Agreement shall be received in evidence in this proceeding without the necessity of any witness taking the witness stand; each party hereby waives its right to cross-examine any witness with respect to the matters in the Stipulation and Agreement and Application.
- 7. That in the event the Commission, after said hearing, accepts the specific terms of this Stipulation and Agreement, the parties waive their respective rights to present oral arguments

or written briefs and the reading of the transcript, pursuant to Section 536.080, RSMo 1986, and their respective rights to judicial review pursuant to Section 386.510 RSMo 1986;

8. That the agreements contained in this Stipulation and Agreement have resulted from extensive negotiations among the signatory parties and are interdependent; that in the event the Commission does not approve and adopt the terms of Stipulation and Agreement and in the event the tariffs agreed to herein do not become effective in accordance with the provisions contained herein, this Stipulation and Agreement shall be void and no party shall be bound by any of the agreements or provisions hereof.




