**OFFICE OF THE PUBLIC COUNSEL'S REQUEST FOR HEARING**

COMES NOW the Office of the Public Counsel and respectfully moves the Missouri Public Service Commission to schedule and hold a public hearing to receive legislative-type testimony **prior** to issuing its final rulemaking in this case. This proposed rule will soon be published in the Missouri Register as required by law. The notice of the proposed rulemaking provides for written comments be filed within thirty days of the date of publication, but the notice also advises that "no public hearing is schedule."

Public Counsel believes that a public hearing with its interactive forum of question and answer, comment, clarification, and follow-up provides a significant opportunity for the Commission to obtain comments and input on the proposed rules by those most directly affected by the proposed rule revisions – counsel for the Staff, Public Counsel, the industrials and other interested parties. Public Counsel believes that a public hearing where counsel who regularly practice before the Commission can provide oral comments and answer questions from the regulatory law judge and Commissioners rounds out and dovetails into the written comment option and will be beneficial to the public, the bar and the Commission. Even if the notice of proposed rulemaking needs to be republished to provide adequate statutory notice of the time, date and place of the public hearings, Public Counsel submits that benefits to a full and thorough examination of the proposed rules and its effect on those parties and their counsel that come before it outweigh any cost, inconvenience or delay such republication may entail.


