By filing this Request for Mediation, Respondents:

- 1. Request that the complaint be referred to a neutral third-party mediator for voluntary mediation of the complaint;
- 2. Understand that the 30-day time period to respond to the complaint will be tolled while the Commission ascertains whether or not the Complainants are also willing to submit to voluntary mediation;
