**ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO RESPOND TO STAFF  
RECOMMENDATION**

On May 1, 2009, the Commission's Staff filed a recommendation regarding Mid MO Sanitation, LLC's application for authority to own and operate a sewer system in Callaway County, Missouri. The Commission's regulations allow other parties ten days to respond to that recommendation, meaning any response from the Office of the Public Counsel would be due no later than May 11. On May 7, Public Counsel requested an additional two weeks to respond to Staff's recommendation. Public Counsel's pleading represents that neither Mid Mo Sanitation, nor Staff, object to the proposed extension of time.

Public Counsel's request for extension of time is reasonable and the Commission will grant that request.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Office of the Public Counsel's Request for Extension of Time to Respond to Staff's Recommendation is granted.
2. The Office of the Public Counsel is allowed until May 26, 2009, to respond to Staff's Recommendation.

3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
