**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND SETTING DATE FOR SUBMISSION OF  
INTERVENTION REQUESTS**

On September 8, 2014, Missouri-American Water Company (“Company”) filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) requesting that the Commission grant it a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (“CCN”) to install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage and maintain a sewer system in Benton County, Missouri. The requested CCN would allow the Company to provide sewer service to the area currently served by Benton County Sewer District No. 1. The Commission will direct that notice be given and set a deadline for intervention requests.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Commission’s Data Center shall provide a copy of this order to the County Commission of Benton County, Missouri and the Missouri Department of Natural Resources.
2. The Commission’s Public Information Officer shall make notice of this order available to the members of the General Assembly representing Benton County, Missouri and to the media serving Benton County, Missouri.
3. Any application to intervene shall be filed no later than October 1, 2014.

4. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
