Staff filed a motion<sup>1</sup> to consolidate these actions and extend the time for filing its recommendation (“motion”) in File No. WA-2015-0049 to match File No. SA-2015-0107. The applicant and service area proposed in each action is the same.<sup>2</sup> Therefore, the Commission will grant the motion and amend the style of the consolidated action accordingly.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The *Motion for Consolidation and Extension of Time to File Staff Recommendation* is granted.
2. The time for filing a recommendation in File No. SA-2015-0107 is extended to February 2, 2015.
