The Company has requested a waiver of the 60-day notice requirements of 20 CSR 4240-4.017(1).

The Commission will issue notice, set a deadline for intervention requests, and direct the filing of a recommendation by the Staff of the Commission.

The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make notice of this order available to the members of the General Assembly representing Clinton County, Missouri and to the media serving that county.

The application shall be filed in the Commission's Electronic Filing and Information System (EFIS) or with the Secretary of the Commission. Comments on the Application may also be made in EFIS.
