- 2. The subject water and sewer operations are owned and operated by the same entity (MAWC) and have common offices, personnel and overheads.
- 3. Accordingly, there are common questions of law and fact in the above-referenced cases and the consolidation of Cases Nos. WR-2010-0131 and SR-2010-0135 would be administratively expedient in that it would simplify the filings to be made by MAWC and the other parties to these matters.
