UNANIMOUS DISPOSITION AGREEMENT

COMES NOW, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), the Office of the Public Counsel (OPC) and Mid Mo Sanitation, LLC (Mid Mo or Company) (together, the Parties) and for its Unanimous Disposition Agreement states as follows.

- On September 11, 2009 Mid Mo requested that the Commission authorize an increase in annual sewer system operating revenues in the amount of \$1.00.
- 2. After Staff investigated this matter and after negotiations between the Parties, the Parties agree to enter a Unanimous Disposition Agreement, representing a black box settlement for purposes of revenue requirement determination.
- 3. The Parties agree to grant Mid Mo its rate increase request of \$1.00. The current tariff sheets in effect for Mid Mo, P.S.C. MO No. 1, Original Sheet No. 1, YS-2009-0845 shall remain in effect, therefore there is no need for Mid Mo to file revised tariff sheets pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.050 (13). The proposed tariff revisions (YS-2010-0605) filed on April 14, 2010, will be withdrawn by Mid Mo before their suspended effective date of August 11, 2010.
- 4. The Parties further agree that this case satisfies Mid Mo's obligation to file a small utility rate case, as ordered in Case No. SA-2009-0319, and that as of the conclusion of this case, Mid Mo's rates will be considered to be permanent rates and no longer interim and subject to a customer refund.

- 5. Within thirty (30) days of the effective date of an order approving this Unanimous Disposition Agreement, the Company will implement the following procedures:
 - Develop and distribute to all current and future customers a written document containing information that specifies the rights and responsibilities of the Company and its customers.
 - b. The Company shall incorporate a contact telephone number and payment due date on customers' bills and clearly state on each bill when customers are subject to a 5% late payment fee.
 - c. Prepare a written notice that could be used to notify customers when scheduling disconnections of service due to nonpayment.
 - d. Develop and implement a process to ensure all customer complaints received by Company personnel are documented and maintained. Documentation shall include the customer name, address, nature of the complaint, date of occurrence, as well as an explanation of what the Company has done to address the complaint.
- 6. The Company shall mail its customers a final written notice of the rates and charges in its tariff prior to or with its next billing cycle should the Commission approve this Unanimous Disposition Agreement. When the Company mails the notice to its customers, it will also send a copy to the Staff Case Coordinator who will file a copy in the subject case file.
- 7. The Staff may conduct follow-up reviews of the Company's operations to ensure that the Company has complied with the provisions of this Unanimous Disposition Agreement.

- 8. The Staff or Public Counsel may file a formal complaint against the Company if it does not comply with the provisions of this Unanimous Disposition Agreement.
- 9. Mid Mo has no delinquent annual reports and does not have any other matters pending before the Commission.
- 10. The Parties agree they have read this Unanimous Disposition Agreement and according to their best knowledge and belief, the facts stated herein are true and the conditions accurately reflect the agreement reached between the Staff, OPC, and Mid Mo, and each party has voluntarily and freely entered into this agreement. The parties agree to support the terms of this Unanimous Disposition Agreement in any discussions before the Commission.
- 11. The Staff also shall have the right to provide, at any agenda meeting at which this Unanimous Disposition Agreement is noticed to be considered by the Commission, whatever oral explanation consistent with this agreement the Commission requests; provided, that the Staff shall, to the extent reasonably practicable, provide the other Parties with advance notice of when the Staff shall respond to the Commission's request for such explanation once such explanation is requested from the Staff.

WHEREFORE, the Parties respectfully request the Commission accept their Unanimous Disposition Agreement.
