ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On July 16, 2010, Lake Region Water and Sewer and the Commission's Staff jointly filed revenue requirement scenarios. These parties will be directed to file the models for the scenarios as referenced in paragraph 12 of their filing.

Additionally, Lake Region and Staff shall explain the summaries of the two scenarios it filed. It appears to the Commission that Scenario 1, which considers imputed revenue from availability fees with no availability fee related rate base addition, results in a higher revenue requirement. This appears to be in conflict with Staff's earlier position that this type of scenario would result in a lower revenue requirement.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. No later than July 20, 2010, Lake Region Water and Sewer and the Commission's Staff shall jointly file the revenue requirement scenario models as described in the body of this order.
- 2. No later than July 23, 2010, Lake Region Water and Sewer and the Commission's Staff shall jointly file a definitive explanation of the two revenue scenarios

submitted on July 16, 2010. That explanation shall delineate, with particularity, how the adjustments to revenue and rate base resulted with the revenue requirements projected.

3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
