**ORDER SETTING DEADLINE FOR RECOMMENDATION OR
OBJECTIONS TO REPLACEMENT TARIFFS**

On October 8, 2014 the Commission issued a Report and Order approving a Company/Staff Disposition Agreement between the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and Peaceful Valley Service Company ("Peaceful Valley"). The Commission also approved Peaceful Valley's water and sewer tariff sheets (Tracking Nos. YS-2014-0425 and YW-2014-0426) to become effective on October 18, 2014.

On October 29, 2014, Peaceful Valley submitted replacement tariffs (Tracking Nos. YS-2015-0185 and YW-2015-0186). Peaceful Valley indicates the replacement tariffs are intended to comply with the rates approved by the Commission in its October 8, 2014 Report and Order. The tariff sheets have a November 28, 2014 effective date. Peaceful Valley requests the Commission approve the replacement tariffs in an expedited manner.

The Commission will direct Staff to file a recommendation and set a deadline for objections to the tariff sheets.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than November 10, 2014 the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a recommendation on Peaceful Valley Service Company's replacement tariffs.
2. Objections to Peaceful Valley Service Company's replacement tariffs shall be filed no later than November 17, 2014.
3. This order shall be effective when issued.
