## **STATUS REPORT**

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff"), by and through counsel, and states the following:

- 1. On January 19, 2023, the Commission issued its *Order Directing Filing of a Status Report* ordering Staff to file a status report as to whether S. K. & M. Water and Sewer Company has complied with the terms of the *Non-Unanimous Agreement Regarding Disposition of Small Utility Company Revenue Increase Request* (Disposition Agreement) and whether any further actions or filings are expected in this case.
- 2. Staff has continued to communicate with S. K. & M. Water and Sewer Company and recently received numerous documents from the Company but has not yet received everything needed to confirm compliance with the Disposition Agreement. The Company has not yet complied with the requirements of conditions 10(b), (c), (h), (j) and (k).
- 3. Staff will continue communicating with S. K. & M. Water and Sewer Company to obtain the needed information. For this reason, Staff's opinion is that the Commission should not close this file.
- 4. Staff proposes to file another Status Report regarding the Company's compliance with the Disposition Agreement no later than March 24, 2023.
