PROCEEDINGS 1 JUDGE STEARLEY: All right. Good 2 3 morning. It's Monday, November 9th, 2009. We are 4 here for a prehearing conference in the matter of 5 Lake Region Water & Sewer Company's Application to 6 Implement a General Rate Increase in Water and Sewer 7 Service, which are File Nos. SR-2010-0110 and 8 WR-2010-0111. 9 My name is Harold Stearley and I'm the 10 presiding officer in this matter. The court reporter this morning is Pam Fick. And we will begin by 11 12 taking entries of appearance, beginning with Lake Region Water & Sewer Company. 13 14 MR. COMLEY: On behalf of Lake Region Water & Sewer Company, let the record reflect the 15 entry of appearance of Mark W. Comley, Newman, Comley 16 17 & Ruth. Our business address is on the written entry 18 that I have previously given to Ms. Fick this 19 morning. JUDGE STEARLEY: Thank you, Mr. Comley. 20 21 For Four Seasons Racket & Country Club Condominium 22 Property Owners Association, Incorporated. 23 MR. JOHNSON: Thank you, Judge. It's Craig Johnson, Berry Wilson, LLC, 304 East High, 24 25 Jefferson City, Missouri.

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1 JUDGE STEARLEY: Okay. Thank you, Mr. Johnson. For Four Seasons Lakeside Property 2 3 Owners Association, Incorporated. 4 MS. LANGENECKERT: Good morning, Judge 5 and everyone. My name is Lisa Langeneckert. And I б will spell that for the court reporter. It's 7 L-a-n-g-e-n-e-c-k-e-r-t. I am with the law firm of Sandberg, S-a-n-d-b-e-r-g, Phoenix, like the city in 8 9 Arizona, & von Gontard, v-o-n, G-o-n-t-a-r-d, One City Centre, Suite 1500, St. Louis, Missouri 63131. 10 JUDGE STEARLEY: All right. Thank you, 11 Ms. Langeneckert. For the Office of the Public 12 13 Counsel. 14 MS. BAKER: Thank you. Christina Baker, P.O. Box 2230, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102, 15 appearing on behalf of the Office of the Public 16 17 Counsel and the ratepayers. 18 JUDGE STEARLEY: Thank you, Ms. Baker. And for the Staff of the Missouri Public Service 19 20 Commission. 21 MS. OTT: For the Staff, it's Jaime Ott, 22 P.O. Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102. 23 JUDGE STEARLEY: All right. Are there any matters that we need to take up at this time? 24 25 MR. COMLEY: I know of none.

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JUDGE STEARLEY: All right. As of right 1 now we have a deadline for the procedural schedule of 2 3 November 16th, and I believe the parties are gonna 4 respond at that time also regarding test year period 5 and true-up. 6 When the parties file their procedural 7 schedule -- oh, I also made note that I believe the parties were contemplating advancing the hearing date 8 9 that we have originally set in that suspension order; 10 is that correct? MS. OTT: Yes. 11 12 JUDGE STEARLEY: March 29th to April 13 2nd. Have I got that correct? 14 MS. OTT: Yes. 15 MR. COMLEY: Yes. 16 MS. BAKER: No one's run that by Public Counsel, so I don't know about that date. 17 18 MS. OTT: That's on the schedule that I 19 sent you. MS. BAKER: Okay. 20 21 MS. OTT: It will be discussed today. 22 MS. BAKER: Uh-huh. 23 JUDGE STEARLEY: All right. Well, we 24 can --25 MS. BAKER: Right. I saw that as

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1 tentative dates, not a set date.

JUDGE STEARLEY: We can further discuss 2 3 that on the prior procedural schedule. You can let 4 them know if those are the dates that you received. 5 MS. BAKER: Thank you. б JUDGE STEARLEY: We already have some prefiled direct testimony in this case, so I'm 7 8 assuming we're gonna move to hearing if we're going 9 to give prefiled testimony from the other parties. 10 And along with the procedural schedule, I'd like 11 you-all to include probably on the date that you filed rebuttal testimony or shortly thereafter a stipulation 12 as to all material facts that are not in dispute. 13 14 MS. BAKER: And when did you want the 15 stipulation filed again? JUDGE STEARLEY: Either somewhere -- the 16 17 same date or shortly thereafter the filing of any rebuttal or surrebuttal testimony. You may want to 18 19 wait for surrebuttal. And I believe that's all I 20 have. So if the parties don't have any other 21 questions for me, hearing none, we'll go ahead and 22 conclude the record portion of this and I'll leave 23 you-all to your discussions. Thank you all very much. 24 (WHEREUPON, the recorded portion of the 25 prehearing conference was concluded.)
