APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE INTEREXCHANGE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

COMES NOW St. Anthony's Medical Center ("Applicant"), a not-for-profit Missouri corporation, by and through its undersigned counsel, and, in conjunction with its Application for Certificate of Authority to provide Shared Tenant Services in the State of Missouri (filed concurrently herewith), files this verified Application for Certificate of Service Authority to Provide Interexchange Telecommunications Services. In support of its request, Applicant states as follows:

1. Applicant is a not-for-profit corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Missouri. A Certificate of Corporate Good Standing from the Missouri Secretary of State's Office is attached hereto as Exhibit 1. Applicants legal name and principal place of business are:

3. There are no pending actions or final judgments or decisions against Applicant from any state or federal agency or court which involves customer services or rates, which

Applicant proposes to provide interexchange telecommunications services within Missouri on a resold basis, including Operator assisted, direct dial ("1+"), and 800 services. Applicant proposes to provide its services only to the tenants of the buildings in one location identified in Applicant's Application for Certificate of Service Authority to Provide Shared Tenant Services with State of Missouri (filed concurrently herewith). Said services will be provided through the resale of services of other approved and tariffed carriers. Operator services will be offered by the underlying carrier.
- 5. Applicant requests a temporary waiver of 4 CSR § 240.2.060(6)(C). Applicant has not yet developed its tariff to fully comply with this rule. At such time as all facts necessary for the development of such tariff are known to Applicant, it will promptly file such tariff bearing no less than a 45-day effective date with the Commission in a manner consistent with the Commission's practice in similar cases. No other utility should be affected by such a waiver.
- 6. Applicant requests classification as a competitive telecommunications company within the State of Missouri. Applicant believes that its proposed services will be subject to sufficient competition to justify a lesser degree of regulation.
- 7. Granting of this application will be in the public interest because it will create greater competition in the interexchange market place and will allow greater price and service options for telephone users in the state consistent with the legislative goals set forth in the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 and Chapter § 392 R.S.Mo.

8. Applicant also requests, pursuant to § 392.420, RSMo., that the Commission waive the application of the following rules and statutory provisions as it relates to the regulation of Applicant:
