**AMERENUE'S LIMITED OBJECTION TO
NONUNANIMOUS STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT CONCERNING
CLASS COST OF SERVICE AND CERTAIN RATE DESIGN ISSUES**

COMES NOW Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE (AmerenUE or Company), and for its limited objection to the *Nonunanimous Stipulation and Agreement Concerning Class Cost of Service and Certain Rate Design Issues* (Stipulation) states as follows:

1. On July 7, 2006, AmerenUE filed, in this case, its request for a general rate increase for electric service provided in its Missouri service area.

2. On March 12, 2007, the hearing on AmerenUE's rate increase request began as set forth in the Missouri Public Service Commission's (Commission) *Order Adopting Procedural Schedule and Test Year* dated September 12, 2006.

3. On March 22, 2007, certain parties submitted their Stipulation, which was not signed by AmerenUE. This Stipulation does not address all rate design and tariff issues, including AmerenUE's proposed economic development and retention riders or its Industrial Response Pilot (IDR). It also does not address AARP's "Safety Net" proposal or the Missouri Association for Social Welfare's proposed Essential Services rate proposal.

4. AmerenUE objects to this Stipulation only to the extent that implementation of the Commission's order resolving the remaining rate design and tariff issues described in paragraph 3 above would require the re-allocation of costs among the rate classes. AmerenUE

does not believe that this partial stipulation on rate design should stand as an obstacle to implementation of the Commission's decisions on the unresolved issues

5. AmerenUE hereby waives cross-examination on all rate design witnesses, except those addressing the unresolved issues.

WHEREFORE, AmerenUE respectfully submits its limited objection to the *Nonunanimous Stipulation and Agreement Concerning Class Cost of Service and Certain Rate Design Issues* filed by certain parties on March 22, 2007, in this case.
