County, Missouri.

SUSPENSION ORDER

On August 2, 1979, Meramec Sewer Co. submitted to this Commission original tariffs in accordance with the Commission's Report and Order in Case No. SA-77-167. The proposed tariffs have a requested effective date of September 4, 1979.

On August 21, 1979, the Public Counsel filed with the Commission a Statement of Position challenging Rules 3(J) and 3(K) of the proposed tariffs. To allow sufficient time to study those rules and others in question by the Staff, it is the opinion of the Commission that certain of the proposed tariffs should be suspended for a period of one hundred twenty (120) days beyond September 4, 1979, the requested effective date, unless otherwise ordered by this Commission.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That the following tariff sheets submitted on August 2, 1979, by Meramec Sewer Co. in compliance with Case No. SA-77-167, be, and the same are, hereby suspended for a period of one hundred twenty (120) days beyond September 4, 1979, the requested effective date, to January 2, 1980, unless otherwise ordered by this Commission:
