On March 9, 2009 TracFone Wireless, Inc. filed a petition with the Missouri Public Service Commission seeking designation as an eligible telecommunications carrier for the purpose of offering Lifeline and Link Up service to qualified households. The company states that it does not seek access to federal Universal Service Funds for the purpose of providing service in high-cost areas.

Notice of TracFone's application shall be sent to all incumbent and competitive local exchange carriers certificated to provide services in Missouri. Additionally, the Commission will set a date by which any request to intervene shall be filed with the Commission.
