SPECTRA COMMUNICATIONS GROUP, LLC D/B/A CENTURYTEL'S APPLICATION FOR COMPETITIVE CLASSIFICATION

COMES NOW Spectra Communications Group, LLC d/b/a CenturyTel ("Spectra"), pursuant to Section 392.245.5 RSMo., as amended by HB 1779¹, and hereby requests that the Commission approve Spectra's Application for Competitive Classification for all its business services, other than exchange access services, in the following exchanges: (a) Aurora, (b) Brunswick, (c) Cameron, (d) Everton, (e) Golden City, (f) Greenfield, (g) Lawson, (h) Mt. Vernon, (i) Sarcoxie, and (j) Savannah. Concurrent with the filing of this Application, Spectra is filing proposed tariffs, with thirty day effective dates, reflecting grants of the requested competitive classification. In support of its Application, Spectra states as follows:

1. Spectra is a Delaware Limited Liability Company authorized to do business in Missouri, as evidenced by the certificate of authority issued by the Missouri Secretary of State, which was filed in Case No. TM-2000-182 and incorporated herein by reference pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(G). Spectra is a "local exchange telecommunications company" and a "public utility," and is duly authorized to

provide "telecommunications service" within the State of Missouri as each of those terms is defined in Section 386.020, RSMo. 2000. Pursuant to the Commission's *Order Approving Price Cap Regulation* issued in Case No. IO-2003-0132, Spectra is a large incumbent local exchange carrier ("ILEC") subject to Price Cap Regulation under Section 392.245 RSMo.

- 3. Spectra has no pending action or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal agency or court that involve customer service or rates, which action, judgment or decision has occurred within three (3) years of the date of the Application. No Missouri annual reports or assessment fees are overdue.
- 4. With the enactment of House Bill 1779, Section 392.245.5 (2008) now recognizes that if an ILEC faces residential competition by two non-affiliated entities then both residential services and business services shall be deemed competitive in the exchange. The Spectra exchanges listed above in the introductory paragraph, to-wit: (a) Aurora, (b) Brunswick, (c) Cameron, (d) Everton, (e) Golden City, (f) Greenfield, (g)

Lawson, (h) Mt. Vernon, (i) Sarcoxie, and (j) Savannah, have previously been deemed competitive by the Commission for residential services² and Spectra now seeks competitive classification for business services as well.

Section 392.245.5 RSMo. (2008) states, in part:

- 5. Each telecommunications service offered to business customers, other than exchange access service, of an incumbent local exchange telecommunications company regulated under this section shall be classified as competitive in any exchange in which at least two non-affiliated entities in addition to the incumbent local exchange company are providing basic local telecommunications service to business or residential customers within the exchange. (emphasis added).
- 5. Spectra's Application for Competitive Classification is not a request for any price changes and the above-referenced tariffs being filed concurrently herewith (attached copies for illustrative purposes only as Exhibit A) reflect administrative changes only indicating the new competitive classification. In fact, Spectra acknowledges that all rates currently in effect for these exchanges will remain in effect until such time Spectra files a tariff reflecting a price change. Spectra will be required to file tariffs for any future price changes, either increases or decreases, associated with these exchanges. Furthermore, Spectra will be required to notify its customers of any future price increase.

WHEREFORE Spectra Communications Group, LLC d/b/a CenturyTel respectfully requests the Commission to approve Spectra's Application for Competitive Classification and its tariffs filed concurrently herewith, pursuant to Section 392.245.5
