On December 20, 2005, LMDS Holdings, Inc., applied for certificates of service authority to provide basic and non-switched local exchange, as well as interexchange telecommunications services within the state of Missouri. On February 8, 2006, the Commission issued an order granting the application. That order specifically granted LMDS Holdings certificates of service authority to provide basic local and interexchange services. The order, however, inadvertently omitted any mention of LMDS Holding's request for authority to provide non-switched local exchange service.

On February 15, LMDS Holdings filed a Motion for Clarification of Order and Correction Nunc Pro Tunc, in which it brings the order's omission of non-switched local exchange authority to the Commission's attention. LMDS Holdings requests that the Commission issue an order correcting its previous order to expressly grant the request for authority to provide non-switched local exchange service.

LMDS Holdings' motion is well taken and will be granted. As recommended by Staff, the grant of local exchange authority will be restricted to dedicated, private line services.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Ordered Paragraph 2 of the Order Granting Certificates to Provide Basic Local

and Interexchange Telecommunications Services and Approving Tariffs, issued on

February 8, 2006, is corrected, nunc pro tunc, to provide as follows:

LMDS Holdings, Inc., is granted certificates of service authority to provide non-switched local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri.
