MOTION TO CANCEL CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

COMES Now the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and moves for the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) to cancel the certificate of interexchange service authority in Missouri of TON Services, Inc. ("the Company") and states as follows:

- 1. On October 11, 1999, the Commission granted a certificate of interexchange telecommunications service authority to the Company in File No. TA-2000-188 and a payphone certificate on May 5, 2005 in File No. PA-2005-0349.
- 2. On August 17, 2010, the Commission received the Company's notice that it would no longer conduct telecommunications services, a copy of which is attached. As the Company no longer provides telecommunications services in Missouri, the Staff moves that the Company's Certificates of Service Authority and any tariffs it has on file be cancelled.
- 3. The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5 RSMo 2000, which provides "[a]ny certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."
- 4. The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing. *State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission*, 776 S.W.2d 494 (Mo. App. W.D. 1989).

WHEREFORE, the Staff respectfully recommends the Commission cancel the tariff and certificate of service authority of TON Services, Inc. to provide interexchange telecommunications service in Missouri.

- 2. The Company began offering domestic interstate and international service in 1999, and plans to cease all operations nationwide on August 31, 2010.
- 3. TON Services Inc. is authorized to offer prepaid card service in the following states:

 Alabama, Arkansas, Arizona, California, Colorado, Connecticut, Delaware, Florida, Georgia.

 Idaho, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts,

 Michigan, Minnesota, Mississippi, Missouri, Montana, Nebraska, Nevada, New Hampshire, New

 Jersey, New Mexico, New York, North Carolina, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, Oregon,

 Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, South Carolina, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Virginia,

 Vermont, Washington, West Virginia, Wisconsin and Wyoming. The jurisdiction of actual calls

 varies.
- 4. TON Services Inc.'s prepaid calling card services are sold only at travel plazas owned by the Applicant's parent company. Flying J.
- 5. TON Services Inc. is non-dominant with respect to the service being discontinued. The public convenience and necessity will not be adversely affected, because customers will be able to receive the same service or a reasonable substitute from a wide array of other long distance carriers throughout the country. The prepaid calling card industry is in decline in large part due to the growth of wireless services.
- 6. Individual customer notice is not possible since the Applicant does not have presubscribed customers and has no customer contact information.
- 7. As an alternative form of customer notice, the company has posted or will post the information required by FCC rule Section 63.71(a)(5)(i) at all Flying J travel plazas. Persons with outstanding card balances will be provided with customer service contact information to obtain balance information and to request refunds.
- 8. Notice has been or will be sent to the State Regulatory agencies, Governors' offices and the Department of Defense, as required under Section 63.71, concurrent with each state's discontinuance and/or this filing. Λ service list is provided in Exhibit A.

Conclusion

Pursuant to Section 214 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S. C. Section 214, and Section 63.71 of the commission's Rules, 47 C. R. R.
