**STAFF'S RESPONSE TO  
ORDER DIRECTING STATUS UPDATE**

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and, for its Response to Order Directing Status Update, states to the Missouri Public Service Commission as follows:

On April 4, 2006, the Commission ordered the Staff to file, by no later than April 21, 2006, a status update informing the Commission whether the parties are negotiating a settlement or whether settlement efforts have been abandoned.

The parties have conducted productive settlement negotiations, but they have not yet reached full agreement. They will continue to negotiate, in the belief that a settlement of all issues can soon be reached.

Counsel for Respondent A&G Commercial Trucking, Inc. has requested that if it is necessary to hold a hearing in this case, the hearing be scheduled for some time after June 22, 2006. Counsel for Staff does not oppose this request.
