On July 14, 2009, the Missouri Public Service Commission issued an order directing the parties to file pleadings discussing the effect of TracFone Wireless, Inc.'s request before the Federal Communications Commission for a waiver concerning annual verification of customer eligibility for Lifeline support service. In its response, the Staff of the Commission noted that TracFone also has a waiver pending before the FCC concerning TracFone's receipt of federal Lifeline support of \$6.50.

The Commission will require the parties to file a pleading indicating whether the FCC's granting of the "Lifeline support" waiver may effect the conditions suggested by Staff in its recommendation filed on May 20, 2009.
