**ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE ADDITIONAL
RECOMMENDATION**

On December 7, 2010, Easy Telephone Service Company, d/b/a Easy Wireless, applied for designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (ETC) on a wireless basis throughout the non-rural Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a AT&T Missouri exchanges described in its application. Easy Telephone is seeking ETC status solely to participate in the low-income programs of the Universal Service Fund.

At its April 19, 2011 agenda meeting, the Commission directed its Staff to further investigate allegations of fraudulent activity by Easy Telephone or its affiliates. Therefore, the Commission will direct Staff to file an additional recommendation after it completes its investigation.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission shall file an additional recommendation no later than May 6, 2011.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
