## ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On October 15, 2007, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion for extension of time to file its memorandum and recommendation, which was due on that date. In support of the motion, Staff noted that a local public hearing is scheduled on October 17, 2007, a motion to intervene and a request for an on-the-record presentation were pending, and Public Counsel's pleading stating its position on Timber Creek Sewer Company, Inc.'s tariff sheets is due on October 24, 2007. Staff requested an extension of its filing date until October 25, 2007, so that it may consider the evidence presented at the public hearing, the intervenor's arguments and position (if intervention is granted), and the revised tariff sheets that, Staff stated, Timber Creek plans to file on October 19, 2007.

In view of this case's expedited timeline and the quickly approaching tariff effective date of November 1, 2007, the Commission will rule on Staff's motion without waiting for responses from the parties. The Commission has considered the motion and finds it reasonable to grant Staff the requested extension with one modification. In order for the Commission to have sufficient time for a meaningful review of Staff's recommendation, it must be filed well in advance of the effective date of the tariff. Because the effective date of the tariff has not yet been extended by order or any additional tariff filings, the

Commission shall require the Staff to file its recommendation no later than October 24, 2007.

## IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The Staff's Motion for Extension of Time to File Memorandum and Recommendation is granted with one modification.
- 2. No later than October 24, 2007, the Staff shall file its memorandum and recommendation.
  - 3. This order shall become effective on October 18, 2007.
