



On October 11, the Staff of the Commission requested that the Commission schedule evidentiary hearings. Staff does not necessarily believe that the cases will proceed to hearing. But due to the December 31 decision deadline imposed by Commission rule, Staff wants the Commission to set a hearing date in case the parties are unable to resolve their differences. At Staff's request, the Commission set aside November 15 and 16 for hearings.

OPC asked the Commission to reconsider its decision. After allowing Staff and OPC to respond, Staff suggested, and OPC accepted, two possible alternative schedules. Thus, the Commission will reset the hearing

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The evidentiary hearings shall be held at the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri, Room 305, on November 21, beginning at 8:30 a.m. These are facilities that meet the accessibility requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act.
