ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO NULLIFY AND CANCEL **CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY**

Issue Date: July 12, 2005

Effective Date: July 22, 2005

On June 22, 2005, the Staff of the Commission filed a Motion to Open Case and Nullify and Cancel Certificate of Service Authority. Staff requested that the Commission nullify and cancel C.C.O. Telecom, Inc.'s certificate of service authority and tariff. The Commission granted a certificate of service authority to CCO to provide basic local telecommunications services in Case No. TA-99-473.

Staff stated that CCO is no longer entitled to a certificate of service authority. Staff stated that CCO should no longer have a certificate because CCO has never filed a tariff, because the Commission is unable to contact CCO by mail or phone, and because CCO did not file annual reports for 2003 and 2004.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) states that a party has ten days to respond to pleadings. CCO has not responded to Staff's motion.

Section 392.410.5, RSMo 2000, states that a certificate of service authority that is not used within one year of the date it is issued shall be null and void. The Commission has reviewed Staff's motion, finds that CCO did not use its certificate within one year of its

issue date, and finds that the certificate is null and void. The Commission will grant the motion.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Staff of the Commission's Motion to Open Case and Nullify and Cancel Certificate of Service Authority is granted.
2. That the basic local telecommunications certificate of service authority granted to C.C.O. Telecom, Inc., in Case No. TA-99-473, is null and void.
3. That this order shall become effective on July 22, 2005.
4. That this case may be closed on July 23, 2005.
