RE: Rate Increase

Dear Sir or Madame:

The KMB Utility Corporation (Company) holds a certificate of public convenience and necessity whereby it provides water service in areas located in Jefferson and Franklin Counties in Missouri. The Company also holds a certificate of public convenience and necessity whereby it provides sewer service in an area located in Cape Girardeau County, Missouri.

Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.200, the Missouri Public Service Commission's Small Company Rate Increase Procedure, the undersigned hereby request increases in rates for its water and sewer service areas.

The Company is applying for the following annual increases:

For sewer service:

in the Cape Rock Village and Tanglewood areas in Cape Girardeau County, \$9,448.

For water service:

in the Crestview Acres area in Franklin County, \$4,637;  
in the Hillside Acres & Sunshine areas in Franklin County, \$2,696;  
in the High Ridge Manor area in Jefferson County, \$4,958;  
in the Lakewood Hills area in Jefferson County, \$21,138;  
in the Scotsdale area in Jefferson County, \$11,858; and,  
in the Warren Woods area in Jefferson County, \$7,339.


