SUSPENSION ORDER

By Order issued August 25, 1986, the Commission suspended the proposed tariff sheets submitted on July 7, 1986, by Kansas City Power & Light Company for the purpose of increasing steam service. The proposed tariffs were suspended from January 1, 1987 to May 1, 1987.


A hearing involving the proposed tariffs was conducted April 6 through April 10, 1987. Since the parties' briefs will not be filed until after the May 1, effective date, it is apparent that the investigation of these proposed tariffs cannot be completed within 120 days and, therefore, the Commission determines that the tariffs should be suspended for a period of six months beyond the May 1 effective date.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. Since it is apparent that the investigation of the proposed tariffs filed herein cannot be completed on or before May 1, 1987, the tariffs are hereby further suspended for a period of six months beyond May 1 to November 1, 1987, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.

ORDERED: 2. That this Order shall become effective on the date hereof.
