ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE

On November 28, 2011, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting Vistavox of MO, Inc. ("Vistavox") certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff to provide competitive basic local telecommunication service in the State of Missouri be cancelled. The Commission granted Vistavox a certificate of service authority to provide competitive basic local telecommunication service in the State of Missouri in File Number CA-2007-0475.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.¹ Therefore, if no request for a hearing or objection to Staff's motion is received, the Commission may cancel the certificate based on Staff's motion.

The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed 10 days from the issuance of this order to file a motion for hearing.
