**NOTICE RECOGNIZING
EXTENSION OF DEADLINE
AND UPDATED TIMELINES**

On March 27, 2013, Rogue Creek Utilities filed requests to increase rates for its water and sewer services. Under the Commission's rules¹, the Staff of the Commission and the company are required to file a disposition agreement 150 days after the company files its request for a rate increase. The 150th day is August 26, 2013. On August 23, Staff filed a motion to extend the August 26th deadline by two months.

As pointed out by Staff, the Commission's rules² allow the company and Staff to agree upon a two-month extension of the deadline. With the agreement, as required by the rule, Staff filed updated timelines.

Although Staff seeks Commission approval of the extension, the rules do not contemplate such approval. It is therefore unnecessary for Staff to file the motion. The

Commission does, however, take notice of the agreed-upon extension and compliance with the Commission's rule regarding that extension.
