**ORDER APPROVING COMPANY/STAFF DISPOSITION AGREEMENT
AND APPROVING TARIFF**

Effective Date: May 15, 2015

On October 27, 2014, Seges Partners Mobile Home Park, LLC (“Seges”) filed a rate increase request with the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) pursuant to the small company rate case procedure¹. Seges provides service to approximately 58 residential customers in located in Callaway County, Missouri. On March 27, 2015, the Staff of the Commission filed a *Notice of Company/Staff Agreement Regarding Disposition of Small Company Rate Increase Request*, which included the Company/Staff Disposition Agreement (“Agreement”) signed by representatives of Staff and Seges. Seges and Staff agreed that Seges’ sewer system operating revenue should be increased by \$2,178, representing an increase of approximately 6.6%. The Office of Public Counsel (“Public Counsel”) did not join in the Agreement.

Seges filed revised tariff sheets on March 31, 2015 reflecting the proposed rates agreed to by Staff and Seges in the Agreement. On May 4, 2015, Public Counsel filed a position statement indicating that Public Counsel does not object to the Agreement or the

related tariff revisions. Public Counsel did not request a local public hearing or evidentiary hearing.

The Commission has the legal authority to accept stipulations and agreements as offered by the parties pursuant to Section 536.060, RSMo 2000. The requirement for a hearing is met when the opportunity for hearing has been provided and no proper party has requested the opportunity to present evidence.² Since no party has requested a hearing in this case, the Commission may grant the relief requested based on the Agreement. Consequently, based on the Commission's independent and impartial review of the verified filings, the Commission will approve the Agreement.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Company/Staff Disposition Agreement with regard to Seges Partners Mobile Home Park, LLC's request for an increase in sewer revenue, File No. SR-2015-0106, entered into by the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and Seges Partners Mobile Home Park, LLC and filed on March 27, 2015, is approved.

2. The signatories to the agreement referenced in ordered paragraph 1 shall comply with the terms of the Company/Staff Disposition Agreement. A copy of the Agreement is attached to this order as Appendix A.

3. Seges Partners Mobile Home Park, LLC shall implement the depreciation rates attached to the Company/Staff Disposition Agreement for File No. SR-2015-0106 as described in ordered paragraph 1.

4. The following revised tariff sheets filed by Seges Partners Mobile Home Park, LLC on March 31, 2015, and assigned Tariff Tracking No. YS-2015-0292, are approved to

become effective for service provided on or after May 15, 2015. The tariff sheets approved are:

5. This order shall become effective on May 15, 2015.
6. This case shall be closed on May 16, 2015.
