ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO MOTION TO
SUSPEND TARIFFS

On May 21, 2007, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a motion asking the Commission to suspend two tariffs submitted by Missouri-American Water Company and to consolidate consideration of those tariffs into Missouri-American's existing rate case. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties not more than ten days to respond to any pleading, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission. However, the questioned tariffs are scheduled to go into effect on June 1, so the Commission needs to act on Public Counsel's motion promptly. Therefore, the Commission will shorten the time allowed for filing a response to Public Counsel's motion.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Any party wishing to respond to Public Counsel's Motion to Suspend Tariffs and Consolidate into Existing Rate Case shall do so no later than 1:00 p.m. on May 29, 2007.
2. This order shall become effective on May 24, 2007.
