RESPONSE TO STAFF MEMORANDUM

COMES NOW Laclede Gas Company ("Laclede" or "Company") and for its Response to the Staff Memorandum in support of the Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement, states as follows:

- 1. On or about May 2, 2000, the Staff filed a memorandum in support of the Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement that was submitted by the parties in the above-captioned case on April 20, 2000. In its memorandum, the Staff indicated, among other things, that the recommended one-year extension period for the GSIP II would allow sufficient time to gain considerable experience with the performance of the GSIP II, and to engage in serious and good faith negotiations aimed at correcting any deficiencies in GSIP II.
- 2. Although Laclede is unaware of any deficiencies in the structure or operation of the GSIP II, which is currently producing substantial benefits for the Company's customers, it is prepared to work with the Staff and Public Counsel in the months ahead on the matters addressed by the Stipulation and Agreement. Specifically, while the Company does not share Staff's concerns, Laclede is committed to making a constructive and good faith effort to arrive at an overall incentive plan that all parties can recommend be implemented upon conclusion of the one-year extension period proposed by the parties. Moreover, to ensure that such efforts can succeed and to provide the

Commission sufficient time to resolve any issues that may arise, the Company is prepared to begin this dialogue as soon as the Stipulation and Agreement filed by the Parties is acted upon by the Commission.

3. Laclede accordingly joins with the Staff in urging the Commission to approve the Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement filed by the parties on April 20, 2000.
