**ORDER SETTING ON-THE-RECORD PRESENTATION**

On March 9, 2009, TracFone Wireless, Inc., filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission an application as described in the above caption. On April 15, 2009, Nexus Communications, Inc., dba TSI filed the application pending in File No. RA-2009-0375. The Commission issued notices and set deadlines for filing requests for intervention. There were no such requests.

Before acting on the applications, the Commission will hold an on-the-record presentation to better understand the implications of the applications, the effect that approval of the application will have on the Universal Service Fund, and other issues.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The judges shall convene an on-the-record presentation on July 7, 2009, beginning at 10:00 a.m. in Room 310 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. That building meets accessibility standards required by the
