Easy Telephone Service Company, d/b/a Easy Wireless has applied for designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (ETC) on a wireless basis. Although the Commission's Staff initially recommended that the Commission grant Easy Telephone the designation it seeks, Staff withdrew that recommendation after receiving allegations of fraudulent activity by Easy Telephone or companies affiliated with Easy Telephone. The Commission directed its Staff to further investigate Easy Telephone's application and to file a further recommendation by May 6, 2011.

On May 6, Staff filed a progress report indicating that it needs more time to complete its investigation. Staff asks that it be allowed an additional two weeks to file its recommendation. The Commission will grant Staff's request.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Staff shall file an additional recommendation no later than May 20, 2011.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
