**MOTION TO OPEN CASE AND CANCEL CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE
AUTHORITY**

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its Motion to Open Case and Cancel Certificate of Service Authority, respectfully states as follows:

1. On April 24, 2000, the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) granted a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services to United Systems Access Telecom, Inc. (USAT) in Case No. TA-2002-239. USAT's tariff, P.S.C. MO No. 1, was approved in the same Order.

2. Staff received a letter dated September 14, 2004, from Paulina Collins, General Counsel of USAT, stating in part "...we respectfully request that the company's authority to provide telecommunications services in the State of Missouri be withdrawn...." A copy of the letter is attached.

3. Because USAT has no Missouri customers, the cancellation of its interexchange certificate is not detrimental to the public interest.

4. USAT owes no assessments or annual reports and there are no other matters pending before the Commission. The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications corporation certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5 RSMo 2000, which provides:

Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.

However, the Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing. State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission, 776 S.W.2d 494 (Mo. App. 1989).

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends the Commission cancel the certificate of service authority of United Systems Access Telecom, Inc., to provide interexchange telecommunications services and P.S.C. MO No. 1 tariff.
