On April 20, 2011¹, Aegis Telecom, Inc., d/b/a Off the Hook Telecom (hereafter "Aegis") requested designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier (ETC) for the purpose of receiving Lifeline and Linkup federal universal service support. The Staff of the Commission filed a Motion for Indefinite Continuance on June 2, which it withdrew on July 12.

On September 16, Staff filed a Request for Extension of Time. Staff explains that Aegis has not submitted a customer form that complies with Commission rules. Staff states that, if given additional time, it believes it can work with Aegis to modify its form or use a form approved by the Universal Service Board. Staff asks the Commission to extend its deadline to respond to Aegis' application to November 1.

The Commission finds Staff's request reasonable, and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Staff Request for Extension of Time is granted.

2. The Staff of the Commission shall file a Recommendation no later than November 1, 2011.
