**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, DIRECTING FILING AND
SETTING INTERVENTION DEADLINE**

On February 1, 2012, Virgin Mobile USA, L.P. branded Wireless Brought to You By Virgin Mobile (“Applicant”) requested designation by the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) as an eligible telecommunications carrier for the purpose of providing prepaid wireless services in Missouri supported by the federal Universal Service Fund’s Lifeline program. The Commission will issue notice, set a deadline for intervention requests, and direct the filing of a recommendation by the Staff of the Commission.

In addition, the Commission will direct the Applicant to supplement its application with additional information required by Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(1). The Applicant provided information pursuant to 4 CSR 240-3.570, but omitted general application information, including, but not limited to, documentation from the Missouri Secretary of State that the Applicant is authorized to do business in Missouri.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission’s Data Center shall send notice of this application to all incumbent and competitive local exchange carriers certificated to provide service in Missouri.

2. Any request to intervene shall be filed with the Commission no later than February 21, 2012. Such applications shall be filed with:

3. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file its recommendation no later than April 2, 2012.

4. The Applicant shall supplement its application with all verified information required by Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(1).

5. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
