**STAFF REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and for its request, states as follows:

1. On September 23, 2015, American Wireless, Inc. requested designation by the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) as an eligible telecommunications carrier for the purpose of receiving federal universal service support funds under the Lifeline program and high-cost support under the Connect America Fund.

2. On September 25, 2015, the Commission established a deadline for the Staff Recommendation in this matter for tomorrow, November 20. As of this date, the Staff has not completed its review of the Company’s application. The Staff has outstanding requests for information. The Staff asks that it be given a 30-day extension. If the remaining inquiry can be completed more quickly, then the Staff will make its recommendation as soon as practicable after receipt of the remaining information.

**WHEREFORE**, the Staff requests that the Commission grant the Staff an additional 30 days to complete its review of the Company’s Application, until December 20, 2015.
