DIRECTING FILING OF STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

On September 23, 2015, American Wireless, Inc. requested designation by the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) as an eligible telecommunications carrier for the purpose of receiving federal universal service support funds under the Lifeline program and high-cost support under the Connect America Fund. The Commission will issue notice, set a deadline for intervention requests, and direct the filing of a recommendation by the Staff of the Commission.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission’s Data Center shall send notice of this application to all incumbent and competitive local exchange carriers certificated to provide service in Missouri.
2. Any request to intervene shall be filed with the Commission no later than October 15, 2015. Such applications shall be filed with:

3. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file its recommendation no later than November 20, 2015.
