Evidence of proper name registrations was most recently provided to this Commission in Case No. TO-97-53 (Re: United Telephone Company of Missouri's Adoption Notice Designed to Change the Company's Name to United Telephone Company of Missouri d/b/a Sprint) and Case No. TO-98-107 (Application of United Telephone

Company of Missouri d/b/a Sprint for Approval of Name Change to Sprint Missouri, Inc.) Sprint requests that the information in those cases be incorporated herein by reference. To Sprint's knowledge there are no overdue assessments or annual reports nor are there any pending actions or final unsatisfied judgements or decisions against it involving customer service or rates occurring within the last three years.

II. MASTER INTERCONNECTION AND RESALE AGREEMENT REACHED

Sprint presents to the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) its application pursuant to the terms of the Federal Act. After weeks of intensive good faith negotiations to address all of the complex issues involved in such an agreement, the parties entered into a **Master Interconnection and Resale Agreement effective March 15, 2002**, between Sprint Missouri, Inc. and **DSLnet Communications, LLC d/b/a DSL.net** (the "Carrier"). There are no outstanding issues related to resale or interconnection between Sprint and the Carrier that needs the assistance of mediation or arbitration.

II. REQUEST FOR APPROVAL

Sprint seeks the Commission's approval of the Agreement, consistent with the provisions of the Federal Act. Both parties believe that the implementation of this Agreement complies fully with Section 252(e) of the Federal Act because the Agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity and does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. The Agreement promotes diversity in providers, provides interconnectivity, and increases customer choices for telecommunications services.

Sprint and the Carrier respectfully request that the Commission grant approval of this Agreement, without change, suspension or other delay in its implementation.

III. STANDARD FOR REVIEW

The statutory standard of review under Section 252(e) of the Act states:

- (e) Approval by State Commission
 - (1) Approval Required. Any interconnection agreement adopted by negotiation or arbitration shall be submitted for approval to the state commission. A State commission to which an agreement is submitted to shall approve or reject the agreement, with written findings as to any deficiencies.
 - (2) under subsection (a) if it finds Grounds for Rejection. The State commission may only reject.
 - (A) an agreement (or any portion thereof) adopted by negotiation that-
 - (i) the agreement (or portion thereof) discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement, or
 - (ii) the implementation of such agreement or portion is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity; or...

Applicant further states that the Agreement is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity in that it allows for full and fair competition and greater choice for the consumer. The Applicant further states that the Agreement does not discriminate against other carriers not a party to the Agreement as the terms of the Agreement are equally available to any other carrier.


IV. MISSOURI LEGISLATION

The negotiated and executed Agreement is consistent with the Missouri Legislation, Senate Bill No. 507, which became effective on August 28, 1996.

V. CONCLUSION

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, Applicant prays that the Commission approve the Master Interconnection and Resale Agreement between Sprint Missouri, Inc., d/b/a Sprint and the Carrier expeditiously.

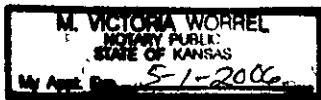
