## ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO FILE DOCUMENT AS VERY HIGHLY CONFIDENTIAL

Issue Date: September 7, 2012 Effective Date: September 7, 2012

On September 6, 2012, the Commission's Staff filed a motion seeking leave to file a particularly sensitive document as very highly confidential. A very highly confidential designation is new to Commission practice, which normally utilizes two classifications for limiting access to information, highly confidential and proprietary. However, Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.135(6) allows any party to file a motion seeking more rigorous measures to protect information from improper disclosure.

Staff's motion explains that improper disclosure of the sensitive document it intends to file could irreparably damage Cintex Wireless. For that reason, Staff asks the Commission to limit access to the document to the Commissioners, the assigned regulatory law judge, the Public Counsel, and attorneys of record in this case. Staff also asks that persons with access to the document be allowed to share the document with other persons associated with the Commission, the Office of the Public Counsel, Cintex, or Cintex's

counsel, but only if the person with access takes responsibility for ensuring that the document is not further shared and that any copies, except that in EFIS, are destroyed.

Staff's motion demonstrates that the very highly confidential designation as described in the motion is consistent with the public interest and is necessary to prevent harm to Cintex. The Commission will grant Staff's motion.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Staff's Motion to File Document as Very Highly Confidential is granted.
- 2. For purposes of this case, the very highly confidential designation means that access to the very highly confidential document is limited to the Commissioners, the assigned regulatory law judge, the Public Counsel, and attorneys of record in this case. Persons with access to the very highly confidential information may share the document with other persons associated with the Commission, the Office of the Public Counsel, Cintex, or Cintex's counsel, but only if the person with access takes responsibility for ensuring that the document is not further shared and that any copies, except that in EFIS, are destroyed.
  - 3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
