ORDER FINDING NECESSITY FOR RULEMAKING

The Commission on its own motion has determined that changes to 4 CSR 240-2.080, Pleadings, Filing and Service, of its rules are necessary in order for the Commission to accept pleadings and other information in an electronic format. The proposed amendments will allow documents to be filed in electronic formats with the Commission at the option of the parties and allow for service on other parties by electronic means. The sections of the rule requiring multiple paper copies are also being amended to eliminate the filing of paper copies if the party chooses to file electronically. Nothing in the amendments will require electronic filing, and paper copies may be submitted under the rules as amended. These amendments will make filing documents with the Commission more efficient and less costly for each entity and each person involved.

The Commission has authority to make procedural rules under Sections 386.040 and 386.410, RSMo. Section 536.016, RSMo, requires a state agency to find that a proposed rule is necessary to carry out the purposes of the statute that granted the rulemaking authority based on substantial evidence on the record. Based on the record, the Commission finds that the proposed amendments to 4 CSR 240-2.080, Pleadings,

Filing, and Service, are necessary to carry out the purposes of Sections 386.040 and 386.410, RSMo.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That the Commission will proceed to make the necessary amendments to section 4 CSR 240-2.080, Pleadings, Filing, and Service by following the applicable procedures of administrative rulemaking with the Missouri Secretary of State's Office.
 - 2. That this order shall become effective on August 24, 2001.
