In the matter of Union Electric Company
of St. Louis, Missouri, for compliance
with 4 CSR 240-20.060, cogeneration
tariffs, for customers in the Missouri
service area of the Company.

ORDER LIFTING SUSPENSION

On October 15, 1981, Union Electric Company of St. Louis, Missouri, sub-
mitted to this Commission tariffs to comply with 4 CSR 240-20.060 (cogeneration)
for customers in the Missouri service area of the Company. By order issued
December 3, 1981, the Commission suspended those tariffs for an initial period of
120 days beyond the requested effective date, to April 14, 1982; and by order
dated April 12, 1982, the tariffs were further suspended to October 14, 1982,
unless otherwise ordered by the Commission.

On April 9, 1982, Union Electric Company filed a Motion to Substitute
Revised Tariffs For Tariffs Filed and Suspended, and on April 13, 1982, an Amended
Motion to Substitute Revised Tariffs For Tariffs Filed and Suspended. By order
issued May 14, 1982, the Commission granted the motion to substitute the revised
tariffs filed by Union Electric Company on April 9, 1982, and retained the
suspension period for those tariffs to October 14, 1982, unless otherwise ordered
by the Commission.


After further consideration by the Commission and upon the recommenda-
tion of the Commission's Staff, the Commission determines that the suspension of
the proposed tariffs should be lifted and the tariffs allowed to go into effect.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That the revised tariff sheets submitted on April 9, 1982,
by Union Electric Company of St. Louis, Missouri, for compliance with
4 CSR 240-20.060 (cogeneration) for customers in the Missouri service area of the
Company be, and hereby are, allowed to become effective on and after October 14,
1982.

ORDERED: 2. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.


