ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On December 1, 1989, the Telconnect Company (Teleconnect or Applicant) submitted proposed banded tariffs for three interexchange services, "MAX-SAVE", "DAYSAVER" and "DAYSAVER PLUS". The Commission suspended the proposed rate band tariffs on January 9, 1990. Teleconnect moved to vacate the suspension on February 9, 1990, after which the Commission entered its order refusing to vacate its suspension. Following Teleconnect's application for relief to the Cole County Circuit Court, the Commission is now advised by Teleconnect's counsel, by letter dated November 26, 1990, that Teleconnect wishes to withdraw its "MAX-SAVE", "DAYSAVER" and "DAYSAVER PLUS" rate band tariffs, thereby dismissing this case.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That Teleconnect Long Distance Service Company Inc.'s "MAX-SAVE",
 "DAYSAVER" and "DAYSAVER PLUS" rate band tariff filing of December 2, 1989, is hereby
 dismissed.
 - 2. That this Order shall become effective on the date hereof.
