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ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On February 14, 1994, the Commission's Staff (Staff), Office of Public Counsel (Public Counsel), St. Joseph Light & Power Company (SJLP), and AG Processing Inc. (AGP) filed a joint Memorandum And Agreement requesting the Commission to set a procedural schedule in this case.

After reviewing the Memorandum And Agreement, the Commission determines that the recommended procedural schedule is appropriate in light of the parties' need to gather and analyse additional information.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the following procedural schedule be hereby adopted:

March 10, 1994	SJLP provides other parties with a copy
	of the water treatment study at Lake Road
	on or before this date.

- March 14, 1994 SJLP provides other parties with data on spare parts and capital account L1315 on or before this date.
- April 11, 1994 SJLP provides other parties with 24 months of electric and steam production coincident peak data for the period ending December 31, 1993, on or before this date.
- April 15, 1994 SJLP delivers to other parties a schedule showing what metering has been installed to date and what metering is planned to be installed.
- April 15, 1994 AGP delivers to other parties a list of meters which it recommends be installed on the SJLP system.

April 15, 1994

Each party delivers to the other parties its proposed allocation procedure in detail to include Lake Road - plant, expenses and inventory; and Fuel and General - plant, expenses and inventory.

May 3, 1994

Technical conference in Jefferson City to discuss, compare and contrast the positions of various parties and address the need and timing of additional procedural activities.

May 17, 1994

Submission to the Commission of a status report containing a proposed procedural schedule for further investigation, proposed test period, and identification of outstanding issues.

2. That this order shall become effective on the date hereof.
