ORDER SCHEDULING HEARING

On January 25, 2000, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), on behalf of the Public Water Supply District No. 3 of Franklin County, the City of Washington, and the Office of the Public Counsel, filed a proposed procedural schedule. The proposal states that the parties believe they will reach a stipulation and agreement in this case and have agreed that the stipulation and agreement will be filed by February 22, 2001. The parties also recommend that an evidentiary hearing be set for March 5, 2001. All the parties have agreed to the proposed procedural schedule. The Commission has reviewed the proposed procedural schedule and finds the hearing date appropriate for this case.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That an evidentiary hearing shall be held in this matter on March 5, 2001, beginning at 1:30 p.m. in Room 305 on the ground floor of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. The Governor Office Building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans With Disabilities
