OFFICE OF THE PUBLIC COUNSEL'S RESPONSE TO ORDER AND NOTICE

COMES NOW the Office of the Public Counsel ("Public Counsel"), and for its response to Order and Notice states as follows:

- 1. On March 4, 1997, the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") issued an Order and Notice in this case. In that Order and Notice, the Commission allowed interested entities until April 3, 1997, to intervene. The Commission noted that if no intervention is sought, it may allow the Applicant to submit evidence by its verified application and attachments.
- Public Counsel does not necessarily oppose the application of Kansas City Power
 Light Company ("KCPL"). However, Public Counsel still has data requests outstanding with
 KCPL. On March 25, 1997, Public Counsel served data requests nos. 1001 to 1010 upon KCPL.
 To date, no response has been received.
- 3. In its Motion to Expedite filed on March 10, 1997, KCPL notes that it has had meetings and contacts with the Commission's Staff concerning this case and that the Staff is willing to treat the Application in an expeditious manner. KCPL also states that no classes of



customers other than the City of Kansas City will be affected by the sale. The data requests submitted by Public Counsel to KCPL are designed to determine whether the relief requested in the Application will indeed have no effect on other classes of customers.

4. As soon as Public Counsel has responses from KCPL to the March 25, 1997 data requests and has had the opportunity to analyze them, Public Counsel will inform the Commission whether it has any objection to the Application.

WHEREFORE, Public Counsel respectfully requests that the Commission refrain from ruling on the Application in this case until such time as Public Counsel receives the data request responses from KCPL and has had the opportunity to review them.
