SUBJECT: Staff Recommendation On United Cities Gas Company's Bowling Green District  
PGA Filing Effective April 1, 2000.

DATE: March 13, 2000

On February 29, 2000, United Cities Gas Company (United or Company) of Franklin, Tennessee filed a tariff sheet proposed to become effective April 1, 2000, for its Bowling Green District. The tariff sheet was filed to reflect changes in the Company's Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) factors as a result of an increase in the cost of spot market gas and the termination of a refund factor.

The net effect of these changes will increase the Bowling Green District PGA Factor from \$0.3725 per Ccf to \$0.3984 per Ccf.

Case No. GR-2000-392, under which this change was filed, was established to address United's PGA factors that will be reviewed in its 1999-2000 Actual Cost Adjustment (ACA) filing. Case No. GR-99-280 was established to address the PGA factors filed in its 1998-1999 ACA period. Interim subject to refund status should be maintained pending final Commission decisions in Case Nos. GR-99-280 and GR-2000-392.

The Company also has pending before the Commission a file to remove the current PGA clause (File No. 200000730) which allows for monthly PGA changes and replaces it with a PGA clause which allows for two scheduled and one unscheduled changes per year. Assuming the Commission approves that filing, this will be the last PGA change utilizing the current PGA clause.

The Commission's Gas Department - Tariffs/Rate Design Staff (Staff) has reviewed this filing and has determined it was calculated in conformance with United's PGA Clause. Therefore, Staff recommends that the following tariff sheet, be approved to become effective April 1, 2000, interim subject to refund:
