ORDER GIVING NOTICE OF AMENDED COMPLAINT

On May 15, 2015, the Office of the Public Counsel ("OPC") filed an amended complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission against Central Rivers Wastewater Utility, Inc. ("Central Rivers"). This is a contested case pursuant to § 386.390.¹ Consistent with the requirements of § 536.067 and Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.070(8), the Commission will provide notice of the amended complaint to Central Rivers. The Commission's provisions governing procedures before the Commission, including provisions relating to discovery, are found at Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.090.

OPC previously filed a complaint in this case on December 24, 2014. On February 9, 2015, the Commission issued an order staying all proceedings in this matter, pending the outcome of mediation. In that order, the Commission appointed Senior Regulatory Law Judge Daniel Jordan as mediator and directed the parties to inform Judge Jordan and file a

notification with the Commission should they wish to discontinue mediation. OPC did not state in its filing that it seeks an end to ongoing mediation.

The Commission will direct notice be provided to Central Rivers of OPC's amended complaint. Since the parties are still participating in mediation, the Commission will postpone setting a deadline for Central Rivers to file an answer to OPC's amended complaint.
